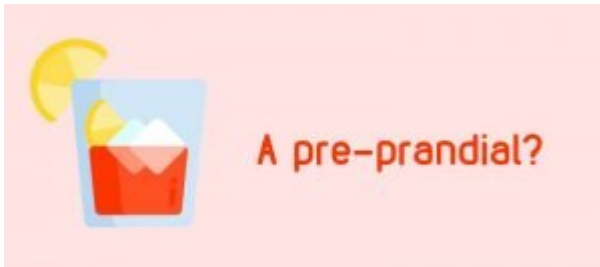


A pre-prandial?
