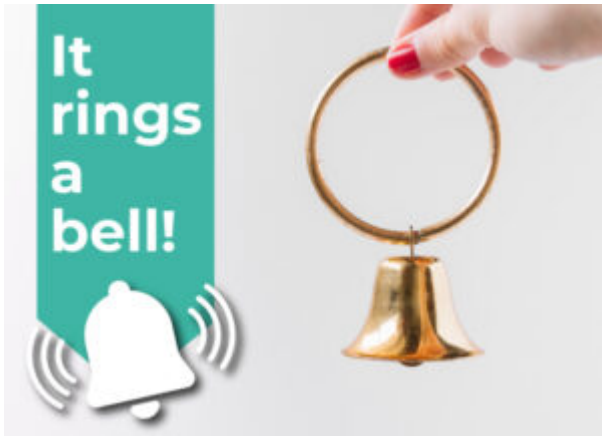


It rings a bell!
