

May be and Maybe

With “may be” we have two verbs, while “maybe” is an adverb meaning possibly or perhaps (*quizas*).

Here are two examples that show the difference:

- Maybe (*quizas*) Mr. Podemos will go and live in Venezuela or North Korea to appreciate (*apreciar*) the lunacy (*la locura*) of his policies.
- He may be (“might be” is also an option) more at home in Venezuela or North Korea (*es posible que pudiera sentirse más en casa en*).

That may be true, or maybe not. **You know the answer.**
