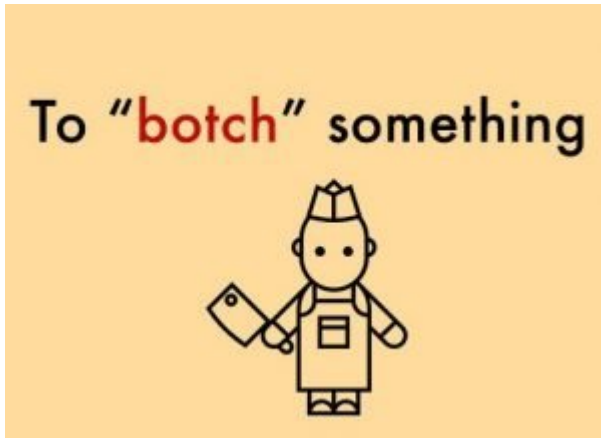


# To botch something
